2nd Reading: Colossians 2:12-14



PRAYING ALWAYS...



The Gospel presents Jesus as praying. It is in the context of his praying that the disciples ask him to teach them how to pray. And the prayer that he gives is the Lord's Prayer, although Luke's version here is not used in the liturgy (we use Matthew's longer version).

To convince his disciples to pray always, Jesus tells of a man who goes to his friend at midnight, asking for three loaves of bread for an unexpected visitor. The friend at first refuses to be inconvenienced; he eventually gives the loaves not because of their friendship but because of his presence persistence.

Jesus then urges his disciples to pray always, using three imperatives: ASK, SEEK, and KNOCK... And he assures God's favourable response. God will not ignore every bit of our prayer, as long as we are persistent.

Prayer is not an exercise of futility but living our Christian identity. When we pray, we are giving witness to the world that we are Christ's disciples; we are connected with our teacher and master and God. We are not swallowed up by the demands of the world. We are liberated from its false teachings that to be happy, we must earn more money, power, and prestige. The world regards prayer as a waste of time and energy. Constant prayer makes worldly demands meaningless and Christian discipleship meaningful. It is a constant refusal to bow down to the modern idols. It is a constant affirmation of our Christian identity as God's own.


AUSTRALIAN CATHOLIC YOUTH FESTIVAL 2019 SUPPORT OUR YOUTH WITH A 'TAP'
